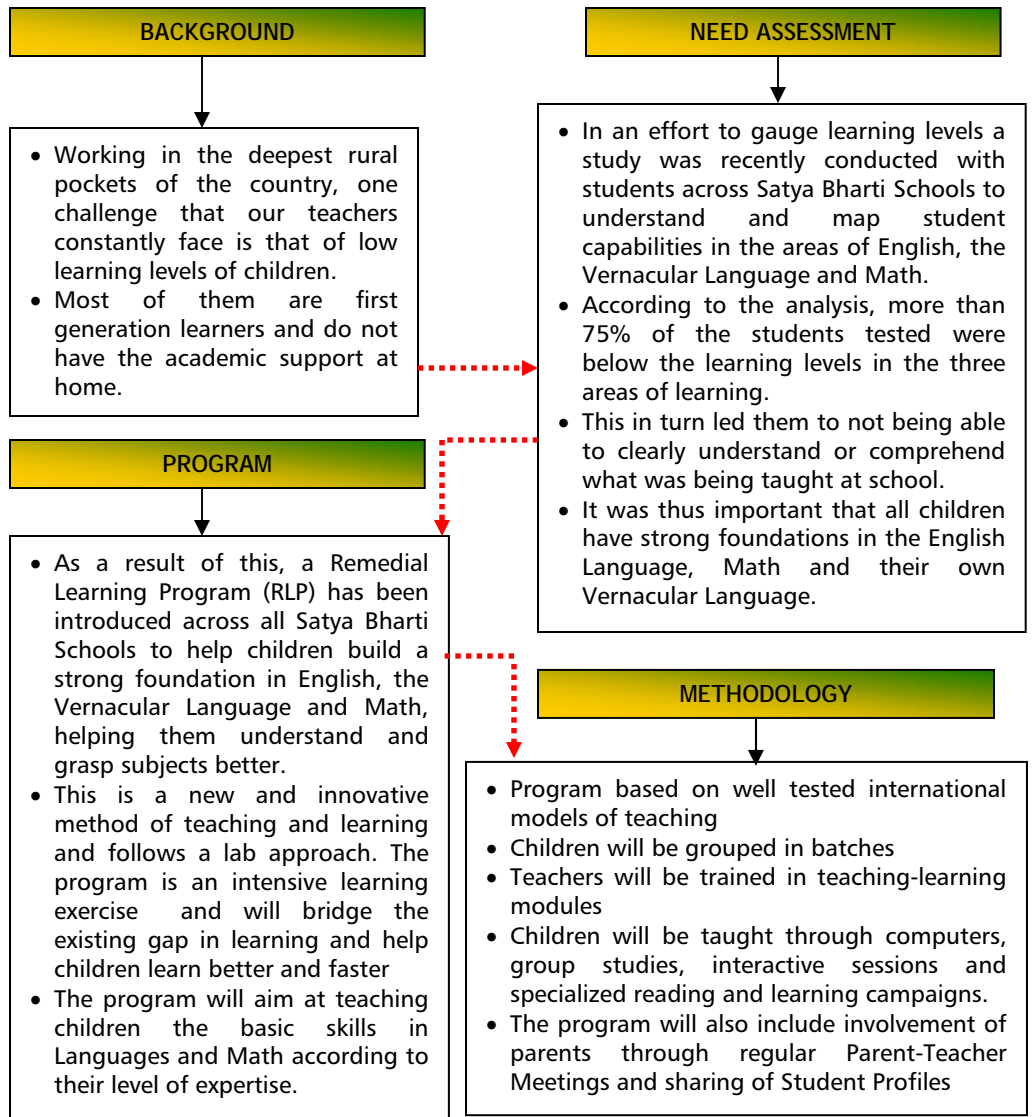

Teaching with a Difference: Remedial Learning Program

On the Path to Excellence: Ensuring Quality at Satya Bharti Schools

Regular audits and performance analysis forms an integral part of the operation process at the Satya Bharti Schools. While Quality Management Systems and Processes have been piloted across the schools over the last month, audits were also undertaken to assess school performance. Conducted on the grounds of **Conduciveness of the Physical Environment** of our schools, **Student Happiness** levels and **Teacher Satisfaction Levels**, the audit aimed to understand and highlight the working conditions at our schools. Rated on a scale of 1-4 (1=poor and 4=very good) all the areas of assessment were gauged on the basis of a few parameters.

Physical Environment

- The overall scores of the schools have ranged from 3 to 4.
- Schools scored well in **campus and building cleanliness** as well as in **child friendly campuses**.

Teacher Satisfaction

- Teacher satisfaction was rated at a steady 3.5 indicating an **overall sense of teacher happiness**.
- This was further supported by **teacher attendance being as high as 3.5-4.0**.

Student Happiness

- Student enthusiasm was rated >3.5 indicating that the **students were spirited, motivated and full of energy** when it came to attending school.
- Student attendance was another indicator of the **student happiness** in majority of the schools and was rated at 3.6



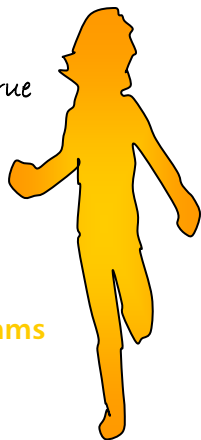
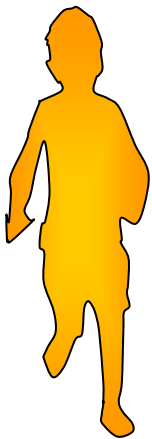
